



## Website Content

### Operational Guidelines:

1. Explicit but non-offensive language and images can be used on educational and information material on TasCAHRD's website only where the use of explicit images and text in education has a demonstrated educational value (including gay men's safe sex campaigns and harm reduction campaigns.).
2. Clear, accurate and unambiguous messages on safe sex and on injecting/drug use practices and techniques are critical, and failure to be explicit may lead to misunderstandings.
3. A general disclaimer is to appear on the website as follows: "Some of the material published on this site may be offensive to some people".
4. While it is possible that such a disclaimer on the website may by its mere inclusion offend some members of the communities served by TasCAHRD, such a disclaimer could be used to defend TasCAHRD if complaints were made about some of the expressions used.
5. Materials prepared by the organisation for the website are to be approved by the President and the Chief Executive Officer.
6. Materials containing information of a technical nature are to be checked for accuracy by a person nominated by the President and the Chief Executive Officer with expertise in the relevant area.
7. In preparing materials for the website, TasCAHRD will take into consideration the needs of people of low literacy and people from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds. Resources produced for culturally and linguistically diverse communities and for people with low literacy skills should be checked for accuracy and/or be focus tested by appropriate representative bodies prior to their display on the website.
8. The TasCAHRD Internet connection is not to be used for downloading offensive material or images.
